The exterior and interior walls of the building, constructed with IntegraSpec ICF and concrete / steel composite floors, has a room to room Sound Transmission Class (STC) rating greater than 50! With total sound isolation for each room, a quiet night's rest is assured. However; the key benefit, safety, is probably the largest benefit. With three hour room to room fire ratings, the opportunity for fire to spread is very low. Natural disaster resistance is increased dramatically, providing much greater protection from high winds, and associated projectiles.
